### SB13-193 INCREASING PARENT ENGAGEMENT IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Passed by the Colorado Legislature on May 28, 2013 and went into effect immediately.

<u>Purpose of the bill:</u> To increase parent engagement in public schools by enhancing SB09-90 (Parent Involvement in Education) and SB09-163 (Educational Accountability) and to help SACPIE (State Advisory Committee on Parent Involvement in Education) accomplish its mission established by SB09-90 by:

- A. Improving parent engagement on accountability committees.
- **B.** Increasing accountability committees' participation in school improvement.
- **C.** Providing additional resources for SACPIE and CDE to work with districts on parent engagement.
- **D.** Enhancing school districts' focus on parent engagement.

## How it does A - Improving parent engagement on accountability committees:

- Promotes opportunities for parents pt participate on accountability committees.
- Gives SACPIE more resources to help accountability committees recruit parents and implement best practices for parent engagement.

### How it does B – Increasing accountability committees' participation in school improvement:

- Makes accountability committees' role more meaningful in advising on priority improvement and turnaround plans.
- Assists school personnel in working with parents in statutorily required ways, such as creating READ (Reading to Ensure Academic Development) plans and ICAPs (Individual Career and Academic Plan).

# How it does C – Providing additional resources for SACPOE and CDE to work with districts on parent engagement:

- Gives SACPIE more resources for member participation in meetings and trainings.
- Gives CDE more resources for working with SACPIE for regional trainings on parent leadership and best practices for increasing parent engagement.

### How it does D - Enhancing school districts' focus on parent engagement:

- Requires districts to adopt a policy for increasing and supporting parent engagement.
- Requires districts to have personnel to support parent engagement.
